The Brotherhood Conference is a strategic Friday night and Saturday morning event built to form men into the likeness of Christ, who is our ultimate example of true manhood. Our heart is that every man who comes to the conference will recognize his worth, have a greater understanding of his purpose, and have practical steps to walk away with. Tickets include dinner on Friday night, breakfast on Saturday morning, and a t-shirt.

This year, registration will cap off at 200 attendees—not because we want to exclude any man from attending, but because we want to create a very intentional environment. We want every man who is there to be poured into and receive corporate and personal formation for their life, and this can only happen in smaller numbers.

We're asking men to commit themselves to being formed into the likeness of Christ (2 Cor 3:18; 1 Pet 1:16). When we take off our old self to become who God created us to be, we will stop at nothing less than all of Jesus for our entire life (Eph 4:22, 1 Cor 2:2).
